GUIDELINES FOR USING OUTDOOR FIREPLACES

Use of Outdoor Fireplaces

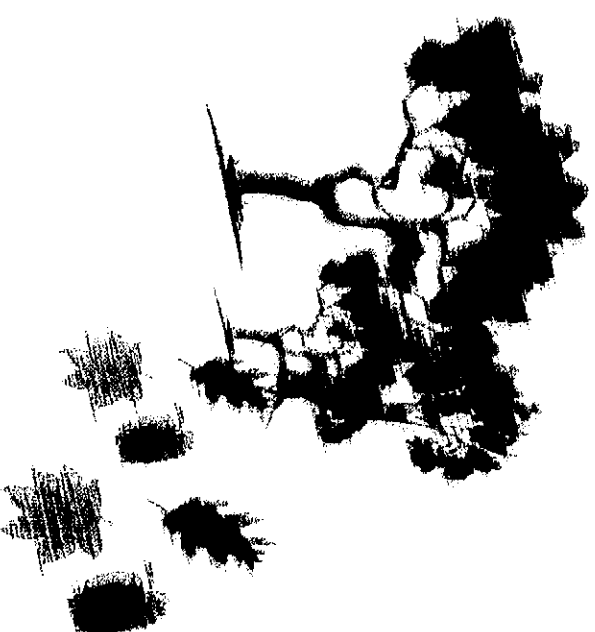
☞ All units are to be assembled following the manufacturer's requirements (lid and screen must be in place).

☞ When in use, the unit shall be placed on a non-combustible surface and positioned away from any structure or combustible object.

☞ Use only seasoned hard woods. Do not burn paper, rubbish, refuse, or yard waste.

☞ Fires must be maintained at a reasonable size. Keep smoke travel away from neighboring homes. Smoke from your outdoor fireplace should not infringe on a neighbor's health, safety, or comfort.

☞ The outdoor fireplace must be attended to by an adult at all times. Take extra precautions if children are present. Extinguish fires completely when finished.



☞ Do not use outdoor fireplaces when wind velocity is high!
