I. CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor Montana called the meeting to order at 6:45 P.M.

II. ROLL CALL:

Mayor Montana declared a Quorum present.

III. PUBLIC HEARING:

Mayor Montana opened the Public Hearing to announce the formal consideration of forming a Special Service Area for the property commonly described by street location as that area bounded by Berteau Avenue on the north, Mannheim Road on the west, Belle Plaine Avenue on the south, and the I-294 Tollroad on the east.

The purpose of creating this Special Service Area would be to pay for the maintenance of a storm water detention basin for the designated area. A special tax would be levied, not to exceed \$50,000 for tax year 2011, with maximum increases of 3% per year thereafter, for a period not to exceed thirty years.

Notice of this Public Hearing appeared in the proper newspapers, was posted in our Municipal Offices, and mailed to the property owners of record bordering this affecting area. No objecting petitions were filed with the Village Clerk and no one was present to make public comment.

The Mayor asked for a Motion to adjourn this Public Hearing, without further notice of another meeting date; upon a sixty day waiting period, the appropriate ordinance can be prepared and presented to the Board for passage.

IV. ADJOURNMENT:

With no further conversation, Trustee Clementi moved, seconded by Trustee Passialis, to adjourn this Public Hearing.

Consensus vote of all in attendance, Aye.

Mayor Montana declared the Motion carried and adjourned the Public Hearing at 7:45 P.M.
