- Asset information (savings, checking, bonds, CD's, etc.)
- Valid Driver's license or State I.D.
- Social Security Card(s)

Due to COVID- 19, clients are responsible for providing copies of the above if requested. If unable to make copies at home, copies can be made at your nearest Currency Exchange. A drop box is available in front of our office Mon.-Fri. 9:00AM – 3:30PM.
